Lori Taylor is a Michigan artist and children's author/illustrator living in Davison, MI. As a traveling artist, and artist-in-residence for Michigan's State and National Parks, Lori has made countless observations in the wild and taken countless *field notes*, the primary sources for her books, zines, and art. What better way to get kids excited about reading, writing, drawing, and nature than getting them to create field note zines to record their observations and to share them with others!

Lori's Michigan chapter book series are packed with science, flora/fauna, history, legend, and humor to connect kids to place. They were selected by the Michigan History Magazine's "Great Lakes, Great Reads" and have been used by many schools across Michigan. Lori shares creative games, free ebooks and zines, and teacher guides on her website to encourage environmental awareness while promoting literacy.

LORI'S PROGRAMS

Kids will take away skills in story hunting and learn to become citizen scientists as they record their own field notes. Lori shares her stories and shows and tells how to go about being a wild investigator of the outdoors!

- **Children K - 2nd grades** will go on a seasonal, sensory *Woodland Walk* puppet program to go along with her *Young Geek's Guide to Getting Outside* book to keep their senses and sense of nature wonder alive. Program length - 35 minutes.
- **Children 3 - 5th grades** will take their own virtual hike and fold and create field note zines to get young citizen scientists excited about reading, writing, drawing, and learning about Michigan's wildlife and their habitat. Program length- 45 minutes
